




Moulton Parish Council employ two Community Connectors, Rachael and Dionne to manage the library and arrange all of our super events and groups. They can be found at the Welcome Desk situated at the library entrance and are there to help you. You will notice a large basket of fruits and snacks on the Welcome Desk, please help yourself to any of these for no charge. We have recently added sanitary products and spare nappies/wipes etc in all of our toilet facilities, please feel free to make use of these whilst you are with us and if you need extra for the weekend then please take some home – all at no cost.

The time table overleaf is split into two sections ‘Activities for all Ages’ and ‘Children and Families’ . Activities for all ages are available all year but the Children and Families activities run in term time only, but don’t despair, that’s only to make room for all the children’s activities that take place during each school holiday. During the summer holidays, over 100 children have taken part in the Summer Reading Challenge, In partnership with ‘Eat’ our community centre café, children have been busy biscuit and cup cake decorating, pizza making, creating magic wands and soil gardens (all edible!). Every Monday during school holidays is ‘Monday Madness’ – our large halls are filled with inflatables and sessions can be booked online. Our free activities include Magic shows, film afternoons with crafts and colouring available every day.

Moulton Library opened its doors 5 years ago and is located inside Moulton Community Centre. In January 2021, threatened with closure, Moulton Parish Council purchased the library from Northants County Council and we became a Community Managed Library (CML).

In July 2021 we applied for and were granted Charitable status - Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) and we are now known as Moulton Library- Health and Wellbeing Hub. Gaining charitable status has enabled us to retain and develop all the services you would expect to see in a library setting and offer visitors so much more.

This leaflet is a snapshot of what is on offer at Moulton Library and we would love to see you – to borrow a book, let the children play in the Children’s Area or attend one of our many groups/events.

Our onsite cafe EAT at MCC offers a full range of drinks, snacks, lunches and homemade cakes.

Whatever your reason for visiting, you will be assured of a warm welcome. The library is staffed Monday to Saturday. On Sundays we operate on a self-service basis but we can still offer you a warm, safe space to relax and read, chat or work.
