Moulton Football Club - Moulton Magpies

Moulton Football Club continues to grow and is now home to over 30 football teams, as well as providing space for 120 people to enjoy walking football. Including the girls and veteran teams, the age range is from age 4 through to 77, so there are activities available for everyone to enjoy.

Moulton Parish Council has recently commissioned architects to investigate extending the current pavilion to provide extra community space at the football club. Come and look at the plans and give us your views.

As part of the Mulberry Homes housing development on Boughton Road, several new football pitches and a 150-space car park is being provided to accommodate the growth and ease the parking at the football club. Plans of this project will also be available to view on the consultation day and we look forward to discussing these with you and hearing your comments.

Youth Provision

Moulton Parish Council wish to improve and enhance youth facilities within the village. This

Climate Change Committee


