

## Roadworks are starting in your area soon

### What's happening, where and when?

**What:** Road Closure- Joint cycleway and footway improvements, vegetation clearance, changes to ironwork, raised tables, and associated signing.

**Where:** Summerhouse Road, Moulton Park, Northampton.

**When:** Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> February 2024 – Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April 2024 (Weekday and weekend working)

**Phase 1** – Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> February 2024- Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2024

**Phase 2** – Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2024- Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April 2024

#### Traffic Management:

**Phase 1-** A diversion will be in place 24/7 as shown on the map in the box below. The **RED** line shows extent of the road closure and footway closure, and the **BLUE** line shows the diversion route. A one-way system will be in place in the direction of the **red arrow** shown on the map below.

**Phase 2 -** A 3-way temporary traffic lights system will be in place 24/7. Footway closure and parking restriction in the location of the **GREEN** line.

#### How long:

**Phase 1-** 28 days with (24/7 road closure including weekends)

**Phase 2:** 20 days (multiphase traffic signals)

**Emergency Vehicles:** Access will be maintained where possible. However, prolonged delays are to be expected.

**Residents/Businesses:** Access will be maintained for the duration of the works on the weekdays via the one-way system that will be in place for the duration of the works. Weekend working will restrict access to businesses on Summer House Road and Kyoto Close. A secondary letter will be sent out to the affected businesses in due course with more details.

A Pedestrian diversion route will be in place for the duration of the works. Please expect delays and plan your journeys accordingly.

**Public Transport:** Buses will remain unaffected for the duration of the work.

**Parking:** To help us with our work, please move any vehicles parked within the **RED** line and **GREEN** line for the duration of the works. This is to enable our workforce to be able to carry out the work swiftly, without delay. We also ask that you park leaving a minimum of 20 meters from any junction for the duration of the works. Advanced 'No Parking' warning signs and cones will be placed in the area 24 hours before. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.





## Parking and Property/Business Access

**We must ask that vehicles are not parked on the road within the works area during the road closure periods. We also recommend you plan extra time for your journeys.**

We hope this information is helpful and we apologise for any inconvenience these essential works may cause. We will make every effort to minimise any unnecessary disruption. Our team on site will be ready to assist you with any issues you may have during the work, and we hope you will find our employees courteous and helpful.
