Moulton Parish Council has a vacancy for a co-opted Parish Councillor.

Would you like to help your local community by becoming a Parish Councillor? There is a lot of satisfaction to be gained from helping run local services for local people. Do you have a few hours you could spare to attend meetings? Are you IT literate? Would you like to be involved with the decision-making processes of Council? If so, we would like to hear from you.

This is a voluntary unpaid role, and to serve as a Parish Councillor you need to be:

- British or a citizen of the Commonwealth. You may also be eligible as a citizen of the European Union, however the criteria has changed now that the UK has left the European Union. Please check on [gov.uk website for advice about EU citizens' voting and candidacy rights](#) in local elections.
- At least 18 years old.
- Registered to vote in the area or have lived, worked, or owned property there for at least 12 months before an election.

You can't be a councillor if you:

- Work for the council you want to be a councillor for, you can work for another local authority as long as you are not in a political restricted post.
- Are the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order or interim order.
- Have been sentenced to prison for three months or more (including suspended sentences) during the five years before election day.
- Have been convicted of a corrupt or illegal practice by an election court.
- Are subject to any relevant notification requirements, or a relevant order, in respect of a sexual offence.
